## NOTES TO KNOW

VCU visits Texas tonight in a reunion between Shaka Smart and Mike Rhoades. Rhoades was the Associate Head Coach on Smart's 2011 Final Four team at VCU. Texas narrowly won last year's meeting at the Siegel Center.

The Atlantic 10's success nationally over the last few years has been evident both during the regular season and in postseason qualification. In five of the last seven years, the A-10 has ranked in the top seven conferences. The league has also had more teams qualify for the NCAA Tournament over the past five years than any league outside of the power five conferences and the Big East.

Davidson's Kellan Grady and George Mason's Otis Livingston II were named A-10 Men's Basketball Co-Players of the Week, while Saint Joseph's frosh Jared Bynum earned the league's Rookie of the Week honor.

Davidson continues to get love in the AP Poll. The 'Cats are receiving votes for the fourth straight week.

Speaking of ranked teams, last year, the Atlantic 10 had seven wins over teams that were ranked or receiving votes. Since the start of the 2013-14 season, the league has won 37 games against teams that were ranked or receiving votes.

A-10 Commissioner Bernadette V. McGlade is taking part in a panel discussion this week on the Changing Face of College Basketball. Part of the SBJ-Learfield Intercollegiate Athletics Forum, the panel will be moderated by Dana O'Neil of The Athletic and includes Jim Phillips, Northwestern Athletic Director, former coach and NABC Board member John Thompson III, Big East Commissioner Val Ackerman and Jeff Hathaway, Special Assistant to the President at Hofstra in addition to Commissioner McGlade.

Saint Joseph's leads the nation in fewest turnovers per game, giving the ball away less than eight times per game. Additionally, Rhode Island's Cyril Langevine leads the nation with 5.5 offensive rebounds per game.

Mason senior Jaire Grayer has been named one of 30 candidates for the prestigious Senior CLASS Award. Grayer, a 2018 NABC Give Back Team selection, does community service work in his hometown of Flint, Mich., and in Fairfax. One of his future goals is to mentor children through basketball.

## ATLANTIC 10 BASKETBALL ON TV/DIGITAL

The Atlantic 10 will showcase 273 men's basketball games live via linear and digital platforms in 2018-19. This includes every A-10 home game and all 126 conference matchups, 96 of which will air on TV, with an additional 30 exclusively on digital outlets. There will be 74 regular games distributed via the conference's national TV package, 11 A-10 Championship games, 72 league-controlled games distributed regionally, 22 appearances in non-conference road or neutral site games. The league's new partnership with ESPN+ will showcase 160 total men's basketball games, 88 of which will be exclusive to the new subscription service.



## CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### KELLAN GRADY, DAVIDSON

Grady finished the week averaging 25.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game, while torching the nets for 71.4 percent (20-of-28), including 7-of-12 (.583) from long range. In Davidson's win over cross-county rival Charlotte, he scored 25 points on 9-of-14 shooting, including five 3-pointers. The guard from Boston capped his week with another 25-point effort, while leading the Cats come-from-behind win at UNC Wilmington. In addition to helping his club improve to 7-1, Grady missed just three of his 14 attempts from the field.

### OTIS LIVINGSTON II, GEORGE MASON

Livingston averaged 20.0 points, 8.5 assists and shot 50 percent from the floor (14-of-28) in two wins for George Mason. He dished out 17 assists and committed just three turnovers (5.7 assist to turnover ratio) while making all eight of his attempts from the free throw line. Livingston poured in a game-high 22 points on 7-of-13 shooting (.538) and dished out a game-high seven assists in 33 minutes against Morgan State. He made a critical 3-point play with less than two minutes left to help Mason secure the win. The guard from Linden, N.J., then tallied a team-high 18 points and tied his career high with 10 assists for his second double-double this season to lead Mason to a win at William & Mary. Livingston made two key field goals in the final 3:31 and assisted on another to help the Patriots close out the road victory. He crossed the 400-assist mark for his career, and now ranks second in assists all-time at Mason with 413.

## ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

### JARED BYNUM, SAINT JOSEPH'S

Bynum averaged 20.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in 1-1 week. The guard from Largo, Md., converted 68.8 percent (11-for-16) from the field and 94.1 percent (16-of-17) from the foul line. He tied his career-high with 17 points in win over UIC, converting 9-of-9 free throws. He also had two assists and no turnovers, for the fourth time in seven games. Bynum then set a new career-high with 23 points against Temple, making 7-of-9 (.778) field goals and 7-of-8 (.875) free throws. He also tied his season-high with five assists. The rookie is averaging 13.3 points this season and a team-high 3.6 assists, which helps him rank 11th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio (4.83).

## ATLANTIC 10 COACHING

The Atlantic 10 has long been a hotbed of head coaches. From John Chaney to John Beilein, there have been several legendary coaches whose reputation as bench bosses was forged or refined in the A-10. A handful of the current A-10 coaches rank among the all-time coaching leaders in career wins. Travis Ford has over 300 wins while Phil Martelli, Dave Paulsen and Keith Dambrot have over 400 wins to their name. And Bob McKillop is a member of the exclusive 500-win club. Paulsen won NCAA titles in Division III while Ford tallied his career wins at a number of schools, including UMass. The majority of Dambrot's wins came at Akron, while McKillop and Martelli have had the opportunity to earn all of their victories at their respective institutions.

## A-10 TEAMS IN THE POSTSEASON

The 14 member institutions of the Atlantic 10 all have successful winning traditions on a national stage. Through their history, they have combined for 342 postseason appearances and the league and its members have made nearly 200 trips to the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. Those appearances have resulted in a national champion, multiple national runners up and numerous Final Four, Elite Eight and Sweet 16 appearances.

Since the 2007-08 season, the Atlantic 10 has sent 75 teams to the postseason, including 39 appearances in the NCAA Tournament by A-10 teams in that 11-year timeframe, 28 of which have come via at-large bids. The Atlantic 10 has sent a team to the Sweet 16 in seven of the last 11 years and each of the 14 the current members have made the postseason during that span. The conference also has won the NIT twice during that time frame, and played in the semifinals or finals in New York two other times.

Last season, for the 11th year in a row, the A-10 earned at least three bids into the NCAA Tournament, marking the 32nd time in the league's 42-year history that the conference received multiple NCAA bids.
